


The Order of Worship

P: In the name of our Triune God: God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.


C: Amen.

- C: Sweeter than honey to my mouth!





P: All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness;

P: Yet so often we have despised God's Word and failed to gladly hear and learn it. For this and all our sins, we bow before you, O Lord, and humbly seek your forgiveness.

First Lesson

Revelation 7:9–17

⁹After these things I looked, and there was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people, and language, standing in front of the throne and of the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and with palm branches in their hands. ¹⁰They called out with a loud voice and said:

Salvation comes from our God, who sits on the throne,

and from the Lamb.

¹¹All the angels stood around the throne, the elders, and the four living creatures. They fell on their faces before the throne and worshipped God, ¹²saying:

Amen. Blessing and glory and wisdom

and thanks and honor and power and might

belong to our God forever and ever. Amen.

¹³One of the elders spoke to me and said, "These people dressed in white robes, who are they and where did they come from?"

And I answered him, "Sir, you know."

¹⁴And he said to me:

These are the ones who are coming out of the great tribulation.

They have washed their robes and made them

white in the blood of the Lamb.

¹⁵Because of this they are in front of the throne of God, and they serve him day and night in his temple. He who sits on the throne will spread his tent over them. ¹⁶They will never be hungry or thirsty ever again. The sun will never beat upon them, nor will any scorching heat, ¹⁷for the Lamb at the center of the throne will be their shepherd. He will lead them to springs of living water. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.


Verse of the Day
