

First Lesson - Jeremiah 17:5-8


A blessed life is not connected to outward circumstances like health and wealth. Rather the one who is blessed is the one who has been given the gift of faith, whose trust is in the Lord.



Gospel – Luke 6:17-26

In one of his most famous sermons Jesus teaches that the good things we seek are found in places we would least expect.
